SELF STUDY REPORT (SSR) OF NAAC: A JOURNEY TOWARDS EXCELLENCE

The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), an autonomous body established by the University Grants Commission (UGC), plays a crucial role in assessing and accrediting higher education institutions across India. NAAC accreditation signifies that an institution meets established standards of quality in areas such as infrastructure, teaching, research, and overall performance. For an engineering college, NAAC accreditation is not merely a prestigious recognition but a reflection of its unwavering commitment to excellence in technical education.

In this context, we provide an overview of the Self Study Report (SSR) prepared by Indra Ganesan College of Engineering (IGCE) for the NAAC accreditation process. The SSR, submitted on 29th March 2024, aimed to offer a thorough self-assessment of IGCE's performance based on the criteria set by NAAC. It serves as a critical tool for identifying the institution's strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and challenges, and provides a foundation for the external peer review conducted by NAAC assessors.

The SSR is divided into two key sections: the executive summary and the criteria-wise analysis. The executive summary encapsulates IGCE's mission, vision, and major accomplishments, offering a concise overview of the institution. Following the NAAC Peer Team's visit, IGCE was initially awarded a B++ grade accreditation status. However, our institution, with determination and continuous improvements, reapplied for an A grade. In 2025, we are proud to announce that IGCE successfully achieved the coveted A grade accreditation status, further solidifying our commitment to delivering high-quality education.










Voting Awareness Program


